


## **Hanging Rows Garden**

The famed Hanging Gardens of Babylon were probably more tiered than actually hanging, but were still a masterwork of horticulture, demonstrating almost-complete mastery of many gardening techniques and tools.



This is a variation on a rows garden puzzle. In a typical rows garden, each numbered row contains one or more answers, concatenated together. Each shaded (or white) hexagon represents a "bloom", which is clued separately. Blooms are always 6-letter answers, but can start at any position and go either clockwise or counterclockwise. The bloom clues are additionally grouped by whether they go with the top, middle, or bottom set of blooms, but within a group, the clues are alphabetized by answer.
